



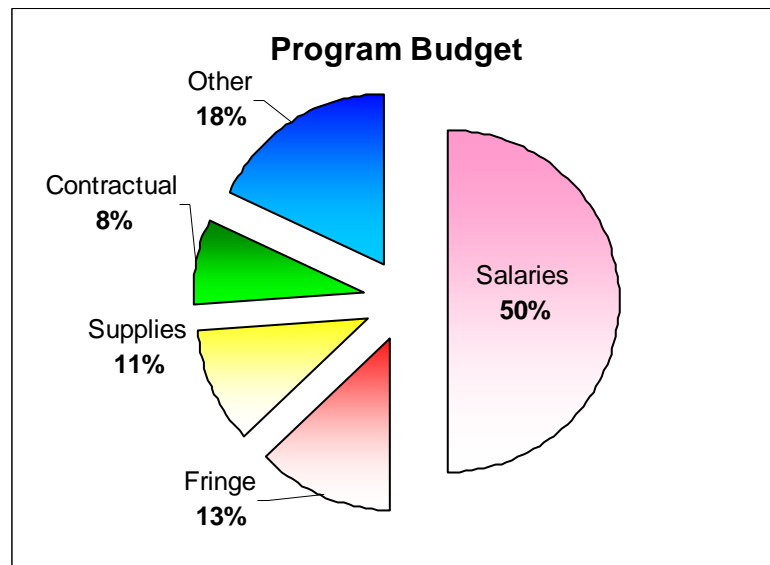
# Scott-Carver-Dakota Head Start Annual Report to the Public Program Year 2/1/09-1/31/10

**Average monthly enrollment:** 100% of funded enrollment

**Percent of eligible children served:** 25% of children birth through four years.

**Monitoring Review:**

The CAP Head Start program received a follow-up review from the office of Head Start in January 2009 and was found to be in full compliance with all applicable Head Start Performance Standards, laws, regulations and policy requirements.

**Percentage of enrolled children that received medical and dental exams**

- 98 % of enrolled children received dental exams
- 96 % of enrolled children are up to date on a schedule of medical care

**Parent Involvement Activities:**

- 100 % of families participated in a goal setting process resulting in a family partnership agreement
- 100 % of families received emergency/crisis assistance and/or education services

**Efforts to Prepare Children for School:**

The four-year-old children in the CAP Head Start program in 2009-2010 began the year at an average of 30% proficient across the domains of social/emotional development, language development, physical and cognitive development. In the spring of 2010, the children demonstrated progress improving to an average proficiency of 83%.
